

UNIT 1: and, both ... and, as well as, together with

1. 'and' and 'both... and' are used to join two sentences.

Example A

Todd likes to play soccer. Jimmy likes to play soccer.

Answer 1

Both Todd and Jimmy like to play soccer.

Answer 2

Both Todd and Jimmy like to play soccer.

NOTE:

'like' is used for both answers. It will be a mistake to use 'likes' or 'liked' in either sentences.

2. 'as well as' and 'together with' are used like 'and'. Keep in mind that the verb follows the first subject at the start of the sentence.

Example B

Dinah goes to school by bus. Dinah's friends go to school by bus.

Answer 1

Dinah, **as well as** her friends, goes to school by bus.

Answer 2


Dinah, **together with** her friends, goes to school by bus.

NOTE:

'goes' is used in both sentences. When a sentence contains the phrases 'as well as' or 'together with', the first person or people (in this case, Dinah) mentioned will determine if the verb takes on a singular or plural verb form.
