unless

'unless' is used to transform sentences where a condition has to be fulfilled before an action or an incident can happen.

Example A

You cannot leave the house. You must have Mother's permission first.

Answer 1

Unless you have Mother's permission, you cannot leave the house.

Answer 2

You cannot leave the house **unless** you have Mother's permission.

NOTE:

Here is a simple example of using 'unless' at the beginning and in the middle of the sentence. The word 'first' is left out as 'unless' has the same connotation.

Example B

If we train hard, we will win the match.

Answer 1

Unless we train hard, we will not win the match.

Answer 2

We will not win the match **unless** we train hard.


NOTE:

Here, the word 'not' is added in both answers. It shows that if the condition is not fulfilled (training hard), then there will be no chance of winning the match. Without 'not', the answers will be incorrect.

Some students find difficulty in transforming 'if' sentences with 'unless'. Thus, it pays to practise more of such sentences.
