prefer ... to

'prefer... to' is used in a similar way as 'would rather... than' in Topic 16. It is used to show a preference of one choice between two given choices.

Example A

I think the red balloon looks best. The blue balloon looks nice too.

Answer

I prefer the red balloon to the blue one.

NOTE:

When both choices refer to similar nouns (in this case, balloons), remember to mention the noun once only. The second time the noun is referred to, use 'one'.

Example B

Father hates to jog. He does not mind swimming as much.

Answer


Father prefers swimming to jogging.

NOTE:

In the case of verbs, 'prefer' is usually followed by a verb in the continuous form (in this case 'swimming'). The word 'jog' in the given sentence is changed to 'jogging' as the sentence would not make sense otherwise.
