whom, whose

1. 'whom' is used to refer to a person or a group of people. In a sentence, 'whom' is found between two persons or groups of people.

Example A

This is the salesgirl. I bought a pair of earrings from her.

Answer

This is the salesgirl whom I bought a pair of earrings from.

NOTE:

The crucial difference between 'who' and 'whom' is that the position of 'whom' in a sentence is between two people. In Example A, 'whom' is between 'salesgirl' and 'I'.

Example B

That woman was dismissed for misconduct by the manager. That woman is now the owner of three restaurants.

Answer

That woman **whom** the manager dismissed for misconduct is now the owner of three restaurants.

NOTE:

It is sometimes necessary to rearrange the information given in your answer. Note that 'that woman' is mentioned once only in the sentence.

2. 'whose' is used to show possession of a thing or a person by someone.

Example C

That is the boy. The boy's mother is a famous director.

Answer


That is the boy **whose** mother is a famous director.

NOTE:

Here is a typical 'whose' sentence. Note that possession (what belongs to who) is not always as clearly stated as in this example.
