

## UNIT 4 because, because of, as, due to

'because', 'because of', 'as', 'due to' are used to show that one event is the result of another or that one event is the reason for another.

**Example A**

The children grew ill. They did not have sufficient food.

**Answer 1**

The children grew ill **because they did not have sufficient food.**

**Answer 2**

The children grew ill **because of insufficient food.**

**NOTE:**

Although 'because' and 'because of' are used in basically the same way, note that in some cases, descriptive phrases (such as 'did not have sufficient') will have to be changed to an adjective (such as 'insufficient').

**Example B**

Helen did not do her work. Helen procrastinated.

**Answer 1**

Helen did not do her work **as she procrastinated.**

**Answer 2**


Helen did not do her work **due to procrastination.**

**NOTE:**

Just as in the case of 'because' and 'because of', a rephrasing of sentence is necessary in some cases when we use 'due to'. Here, the verb 'procrastinated' has to be changed to the noun 'procrastination'. There is no tense change in either answers.
