

## UNIT 5

## although, even though, furthermore, moreover

1. 'although' and 'even though' are used in similar ways. They are used when an action in the latter part of the sentence is carried out despite the first part of the sentence.  
Both can be used at the beginning or in the middle of sentences.

**Example A**

Alec failed his driving test three times. Alec is determined to pass his driving test the fourth time.

**Answer 1**

**Although** Alec failed his driving test three times, he is determined to pass it the fourth time.

**Answer 2**

Alec is determined to pass his driving test the fourth time **even though** he failed the first three times.

**NOTE:**

Note that the sequence of the sentence is switched when 'even though' is used in the middle of the sentence. Such will be the case too if 'although' is used in the middle of the sentence. Note also that 'Alec' and 'driving test' are mentioned once only in each sentence. They are replaced by 'he' and 'it' where necessary in the second part of the sentence.

2. 'furthermore' and 'moreover' are used to show that there is additional information in the sentence which emphasizes the beginning

**Example B**

The strawberry sorbet Mother made helped cool us down. The strawberry sorbet tasted delicious too.

**Answer 1**

The strawberry sorbet Mother made helped cool us down and, **moreover**, it tasted delicious.

**Answer 2**


The strawberry sorbet Mother made helped cool us down, **furthermore**, it tasted delicious.

**NOTE:**

Remember to add in commas. In some cases, 'and' is used too as a further emphasis.
