

**none, all**

'none' is used to mean *nothing* in a sentence.

'all' is used to mean *everything* in a sentence.

Example 1

There were no more pastries left on the tray.

None of the pastries was left on the tray.

Example 2

He did not have any of his father's talent for business.

He had none of his father's talent for business.

Example 3

No one here betrayed your secret.

None of us betrayed your secret.

Example 4

Every bird flew off when they heard the gunshot.

All the birds flew off when they heard the gunshot.

Example 5

The baker dusted each doughnut with sugar.

The baker dusted all the doughnuts with sugar.
